Approval of Minutes - Stefanie Wilcox was present at the August meeting. Approved by consensus.

Administrator Updates -

Director Updates – Had safety meeting after last SMEC meeting. Was well attended – about 24 people in attendance. Broke into 3 subcommittees. Have a group working on access - key access to getting in and door for the buildings. A group for general safety – classroom, perimeter, general safety. A group for emergency planning and disaster recovery. 4-5 people in each group. Once we have an action plan then we will have a group focus on funding.

Chapel HVAC has been repaired. HVAC in commons has been submitted as part of EANS. Can't do that work while school is in session. Lighting and ceilings have been done in boys and girls locker rooms. A contractor is working on a quote for the sound system for the commons, the high school gym, and the elementary school gym. Sounds systems will be covered by EANS.
