One of the primary roles of a Christian is to lead others to Christ. He is one of many saints who encourage us to persevere constantly no matter what the circumstances. St. Teresa of Avila encouraged others by urging them "to be content in the knowledge they are a child of God". Encouragement is simple, but not easy in a world where we are busy and often too focused on ourselves rather than lifting up others. May our encouragement help to foster hope and healing in those who are hurting, angry, and feeling misunderstood.
