Catholic Fact: Did you know the summit of the liturgical year is the Sacred Triduum?

The Triduum begins the evening of Holy Thursday and continues to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil. On Holy Thursday, the Mass of the Lord's Supper commemorates the Passover meal that Jesus shared in the Upper Room with the apostles on the night before he died. Before the meal, he washed their feet to impress upon them the call to serve others. The church recognizes the Last Supper as the institution of the priesthood, and the Sacrament of Holy Orders. During the Last Supper, Jesus also instituted the Eucharist by transforming bread and wine into his own body and blood. Afterward, Jesus went to the Gethsemane where he suffered the Agony in the Garden, the betrayal of Judas, and the brutality of being arrested. The Mass of the Last Supper is a dramatic liturgy with the priest humbly washing the feet of 12 parishioners. After Communion, the altar and sanctuary are stripped bare, and there is a procession with the Blessed Sacrament, which is taken to a separate Altar of Repose, usually located on a side altar or in a chapel. There is no dismissal or final blessing. It is the last time the Eucharist will be celebrated until the Easter Vigil. People leave in silence, but continue to keep a vigil with Jesus in their hearts in anticipation of the events Catholic commemorate the second day of the Triduum: Good Friday. - *adapted from Western Kentucky Catholic*
