Catholic Fact: Today is the Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows or "Mater Dolorosa".

Veneration to Our Lady of Sorrows can be traced back to the middle ages, and was promoted by Benedictine Monks, St Bridget of Sweden and other saints. So . . . why do Catholics venerate Our Lady in her Sorrows? It's a way that we can identify with our Lady, who very often, and rightly, seems out of reach for us. Even though she is sinless, perfect and the Mother of God, she understands and empathizes with our sufferings because she herself suffered. The Sorrows of Mary are seven sad events that occurred in the life of Our Lady, and are recorded in the Bible: 1) The Prophecy of Simeon (Luke 2:25-35), 2)The Flight into Egypt (Matthew 2:13-15), 3) The Loss of the Child Jesus in the Temple (Luke 2:41-51), 4) Mary Meets Jesus on the Via Dolorosa (Luke 23:26-31), 5) The Crucifixion (John 19:17-18, 25-30), 6)The Body of Jesus is Removed from the Cross (Mark 15:43-47), 7) The Burial of Jesus (John 19:39-42). Our faithfulness and devotion to God doesn't promise us material wealth or a life free of suffering on earth. It promises us the chance for true joy and meaning in our lives on this earth, despite our hardships, and eternal happiness with God in heaven when this life is over.
