Catholic Fact: Today the church celebrates the Presentation of Our Lord, Candlemas, and more.

The Feast of Candlemas commemorates the moment when Mary and Joseph, in obedience to Jewish law, present Jesus to God in the Temple. This act symbolizes Jesus' consecration to God and acknowledges Him as the long-awaited Messiah. Candles symbolize Jesus as the Light of the World, fulfilling the prophecy of Isaiah (9:2). Candlemas is a beautiful celebration that invites us to reflect on the significance of Christ's presentation, the proclamation of Simeon, and the enduring light that Jesus brings into our lives. Pope St. John Paul II designated Candlemas as the World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life. He attached it to "Candlemas Day" because the consecrated men and women are to be the light in the world, imitating Jesus, the Light of the World.
